Parker, my daughter Abeline Briggs Wife of Henry B. Briggs, my son Henry B. Parker and my John R. Parker as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by Sally Parker Abeline Briggs, Henry B. Parker and John R. Parker at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Sally B. Parker, Abeline Briggs, Henry B. Parker & John R. Parker their heirs, executors administrators and assigns all my right, title, interest or claim, in and to a certain negro man slave named Preston, it being the same negro man Preston that Thomas Fitzhugh gave by his last will and testament bequeathed to my deceased Rebecca and at her death to her children as well more fully appear by reference to said Will, which is of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, to the said Sally B. Parker, Abeline Briggs, Henry B. Parker and John R. Parker to them and their heirs forever: and the said Henry Parker for himself his executors & assigns the said right, title and interest unto the said Sally B. Parker, Abeline Briggs Henry B. Parker and John R. Parker their executors administrators and assigns, against the claim of him the said Henry Parker his executors and assigns, and against the claim of all and every person or persons whatever, shall and will warrant and forces defend by these presents. This Indenture, made this 14th day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between William Loyal of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jeph Drury of the said County, of the other part, whereas Silas Ellsworth of the said County is security to a repaying bond executed by Lucy Newson to Annany Ayed, as exec of Jeph Newson and which said bond has since intermarried with the above named William Loyal, and the said Loyal having executed on this like bond with Jeph Drury, Casswell Howell & Simon & William Newsons, which bond was due the 28th of January eighteen hundred and thirty four and executed to said Ellsworth exec of Jeph Newson's last will, and whereas Jacob Williams Guardian for the said Silas Ellsworth is a part in the Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton County and the said Williams Drury is willing, agrees and obligates himself to secure the said Silas Ellsworth, This Indenture therefore witnesseth, that the said Loyal, as well in consideration of the premises aforesaid as of the dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jeph Drury, the receipt whereof the said William Loyal doth hereby acknowledge
