

page, both granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents, with grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said Jesse Drury his heirs or assigns, all his right and title in the lands of the aforesaid estate belonging. To have and to hold the said lot of land, with the slaves and Williams Doyal his heirs executors or administrators shall well and truly pay the amount thereof or any part thereof or at any time attempt to remove his property out of this County, same and safety, but it untill the said Charles Calverton shall direct the sale of the same, and place at least twenty days to ten or more public places in this County, and the proceeds of the said sale, after paying thereout all the expenses attending the execution of this trust shall be applied by the said Jesse Drury to the payment of the above aforesaid debts and the balance if any pay to the said William Doyal his heirs or assigns.
