Wife have for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred dollars to them in hand paid and
before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have
bargained and sold and by these presents with each of them the said James Bryant and Nancy his
Wife sell unto the said Lewis Wick his heirs and assigns a certain tract or lot of Land lying and
being in the aforesaid County of Southampton bounded by the lands of the following named persons
to wit, William Bryant the heirs of Lewis Norrell dead, and the above named Lewis Wick, I being
identically the lands formerly Drury Bryants, that is to say the said James Bryants distribution
share of the same and supposed to contain about one hundred and thirty acres of Land, the matter
itself whether more or less, to have and to hold the said tract or lot of Land and every part
