Martha Hill his wife, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part,
and Benjamin Deal of the County of Stafford and State of North Carolina of the other part: Witnesseth
that the said John Barrett & Margaret his Wife, Allen Hill and Martha his Wife for use and con-
sideration of the sum of twenty five dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
Benjamin Deal at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents as well each of their said parts, together with
allies, assigns and confirm unto him the said Benjamin Deal his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract
lot or parcel of Land and premises (situate) lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton,
and parish of Saint Luke's, containing by a late survey thirty five acres (to be more or less) &
being part of the lower land of Mrs. Martha Hill and and evidence to be equal in value to one fourth
of the whole of said lower land, and bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at the butt-hill, known as a
