

This Indenture made this 18th day of Decr. Eighteen hundred and twenty four, by
Henry C. Ernies and Martha his wife, who was Martha Boykin his wife of Edmon Boykin and of
the County of Johnson and State of North Carolina, of the one part, and John Barrett of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Henry C. Ernies and Martha
his wife in consideration of six hundred & fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Barret,
it is before the concluding and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
have made and sealed and by these presents do, and each of us do, bargain and sell unto the
said John Barrett, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, lying in the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia, it being the lot or parcel of Land that was allotted by the Commis-
sioners appointed by the County Court, to the said Henry C. Ernies, in right of his wife Martha
in the division of the Lands of Edwin Boykin and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a
Maple or corner for lot No. 1 in Richard Blant and. line Thence along lot No. 1 S 88° E 36 poles to a white
oak, thence N 73½° E 32 poles to a post oak Thence across the swamp along the boundary S 19°
E 31½ poles to a post at corner in lot No. 2 Thence S 73° W 10 poles to a post Thence N 3½° E 115
poles to a turkey oak corner for lot No. 3 in the line of lot No. 4, Thence along the line of lot
No. 4 N 80° W 18 poles to an ash at corner in Nathl. J. Williams line, Thence his line off the
boundary to a beech Thence N 85° W 113½ poles to a small beech standing in the horn branch
corner of said Nathl. J. Williams in the said Blants line Thence up said branch to a black gum
tree a line of marshes to the begining, containing, one hundred and sixteen & half acre
or all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said John Bar-
rett his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only purpose we are behove of the said John Barret
his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Henry C. Ernies & Martha his wife, for themselves
and their heirs, the said tract of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before men-
tioned, unto the said John Barrett his heirs and assigns free from the claims or demands of them the
said Henry C. Ernies & Martha his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every
person or persons whatsoever, shall, will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness where-
