This Indenture made and entered into on this 12th day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty two between Alfred Story and Dicy Story his wife of the County of Warren and State of Virginia of the one part and John Hargrave of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Alfred Story and Dicy his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said John Hargrave at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do, and each of them with consent, bargain sell convey and confirm unto him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises, situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke, containing by estimation one hundred and nine & half acres (be the same, more or less) and known as follows, to wit, Beginning at a post oak a corner for Marney Maget in John Torgersons line, thence or long said Marney Maget's line to the line of Pilgrims Nick's line, alias William Story's line thence along the said Nick's or Story's line to the run of the bottom Swamp, thence down the run of the said Swamp to a small Branch, Allen's Corner, thence up the run of the said Branch, along said Allen's line to a sweet gum a corner for Thos M. Norrell, thence along his line to a red oak a corner for the said John Torgerson's line thence along said red oak line to said John Torgerson's line thence along said John Torgerson's line to the fork station. Together with all right title interest claim or demand of or in to the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises, with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever) And the said Alfred Story and Dicy his Wife for themselves their heirs executors and assigns do and each of them with hereby licent and agree to and with the the said John Hargrave his heirs executors and assigns that they will by their presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claim or demand of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
