 of the said Africa Story and continued. And in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1836
 the same was fully proved, as to said Africa Story, by the affirmations of Just Jordan a Minister there to,
 and together with the certificate annexed of the said Just Jordan a Minister there to,
 and the certificate of the said Just Jordan a Minister there to, and acknowledgment of Dicy Story his
 wife, submitted to read. And at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 21st day of November
 1836. The said Indenture was entered upon the proceedings of the day

This Indenture made and entered into on the 12th day of April in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between William Story & Polly Story his wife and Sally Nick all of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Hargrave of the same County and
 State of the other part: Witnesseth, that the said William Story and Polly his wife and Sally Nick
 for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars current money of this Commonwealth to them
 in hand paid by the said John Hargrave, at or before the executing and delivery of these presents,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and con-
 firm'd, and by these presents do, and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien convey and
 confirm unto him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or par-
 cel of Land and premises, situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton of
 Parish of Saint Lukes, containing by estimation one hundred and sixty acres (be the same,
 more or less) it being the Land of which Ingram Nick died seised, and bounded by the lands
 of Just Jordan, Richard C. Morrell and Africa Story and others. Together with all the right, title,
 interest claim or demand of in and to the above described tract or parcel of Land and prem-
 ises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to
 hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appur-
 tenances thereto belonging unto him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever (to
 use for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Hargrave his heirs and assigns forever
 and for the said William Story & Polly his wife and Sally Nick for themselves, their and each of their
 heirs executors and administrators, as hereby covenant and agree to and with the said John Hargrave
 his heirs executors, administrators and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and defend
 all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or
 parcel thereof against the Claim or demand of all & every other person or persons whatsoever. In
 Witness whereof the said William Story & Polly his wife, and Sally Nick, have hereunto set their
 hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
