 aforesaid in the State of Virginia, do hereby certify that Polly Story the wife of William Story
 two parties to a certain deed bearing date on the 12th day of April 1836 and hereunto annexed
 personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid, and being examined by us (privately and apart
 from her husband and having the said aforesaid fully explained to her, she the said Polly Story
 acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declares that she has willingly signed
 and sealed the same, and that she wishes not to retract it. Given under our hands
 and sealed this 12th day of April 1836.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 19th day of September 1836.

This Indenture was proved by the oath of Darden H. Bryant and Benjamin C. Burns
 Thors, as to William Story and Polly Nick, and continued. Also in the Clerks Office the
 17th day of October 1836 the same was fully proved, as to them, by the affirmation of Jas
 Jordan & Wm. Thors, and, together with the certificate annexed of the foregoing examination
 and acknowledgement of Polly Story the wife of William Story, admitted to record. And
 at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 1st day of November 1836. The said Indenture
 was entered upon the proceedings of the day.

This Indenture made and entered into this 12th day of October one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty-six between Benjamin C. Burns of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of
 the one part and John Margrave of the same County and State, of the other part, one thousand
 three hundred and six dollars trustee of the aforesaid County & State of the third part. Minus the said Benjamin C. Burns
 having justly indebted to the said John Margrave in the sum of three hundred & only seven dollars
 38/100, due by note bearing date the 12th day of October 1836, and the said Benjamin C.
 Burns being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid debt & interest unto the
 said John Margrave his heirs executors & administrators, hath bargained sold and conveyed one of the
 presents a bargain sold & convey unto the said John C. Turner, who was mutually chosen to transact
 by the parties, one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
 containing one hundred and sixty five acres, to the same more or less, known as the land formerly
 belonging to Jessie Newsom deceased with all the privileges and advantages thereto belonging unto him the
 said John C. Turner his heirs executors & administrators. And the said Benjamin C. Burns for himself, his heirs &
 executors & administrators. But if the aforesaid Benjamin C. Burns his heirs executors & administrators shall within one year pay
 the aforesaid debt interest & cost that may accrue, or on or before the 12th day of October 1837 in
 that case the aforesaid trustee shall release unto him the said Burns the aforesaid tract or
 tract of Land with all its privileges and advantages. But if the aforesaid Benjamin C. Burns
 shall fail to pay the aforesaid debt interest and cost on or before the 12th day October 1837
 then in that case the aforesaid John C. Turner trustee shall at the order of either he and
 John Margrave or the said Burns, expose the aforesaid land & premises to public sale by au-
 licition and giving ten days notice at there to more public places in the neighbourhood, and
 of the proceeds of such sale pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt int and cost and the surplus of
 any there to pay over unto the said Benjamin C. Burns his heirs executors & administrators. In
