This Indenture made this 7th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six between Nathan Salter of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Mills Corbett of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth, that the said Nathan Salter for and in consideration of the sum of eleven dollars & thirty one and one fourth cent, current money of Virginia, to him in hand paid by the said Mills Corbett, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, confirmed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, unto the said Mills Corbett his heirs and assigns forever one certain piece or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing by estimation two acres one Rod & one Rod, be the same more or less and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a forked red oak a corner of the said Salter, Samuel Corbett Son of Mills Corbett to a water oak standing in Peason Branch adjoining the land that formerly belonged to John Joyner, thence along a line of marked trees down the Branch to a water oak a corner of the John Joyner land, Micajah Joyner deceased Land of Saml Corbett Senr, and from thence a straight line of marked trees to the beginning. Together with all Houses, out Houses, Cattle, fields, buildings, yards, gardens, orchards, ways, Meters and watercourses, whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Tract or parcel of Land and premises, to have and to hold the same unto the said Mills Corbett to him and his heirs forever. And the said Nathan Salter for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Mills Corbett, his heirs and assigns, that he will by these presents, warrant and forever defend all right, title, claim or demand, of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof the said Nathan Salter hath hereunto set his hands and affixed his seal this day and year within written.
