 ing in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's containing, by a late survey, six
 hundred and sixteen acres (be the same more or less) it being the lot or parcel of Lande the said
 John Barrett Purchaser of Henry C. Conner in right of his Wife Martha Conner who was Martha
 Bygkin heir of Edwin Bygkin decd. said lot or parcels of Lande was drawn by the said Henry
 Conner in right of his wife Martha in the division of the Lande of Edwin Bygkin decd. as per
 Commissioner's Report in the division of the said Lande will show; together with all right, title, in-
 terest claim or demand of in and to the above described tract, lot or parcels of Lande and premises
 with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtening, to have and to hold the aforesaid tract,
 lot or parcels of Lande and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the
 said Edwin Bygkin his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him
