Barnett, acknowledges the same to be her act and deed and avows that she had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it. This Indenture was proved by the oath of Jacob Barnett & Williams Boon, witnesses thereto, as to John Barnett, and the same having been proved, as to him, in the office, on the 15th day of August 1836 by the oath of Alexander Myrick as Minors' Clerk, and, together with the certificate, annexed of the Spring examinations and acknowledgments of Margaret P. Barnett his Wife, submitted to record. And at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 20th day of November 1836 the said indenture was entered upon the proceedings of this day.

This Indenture made and entered into on the 14th day of May in the year of our Lord
 Reese & Wife Eighteen Hundred and thirty-six between Sampson L. Reese and Mary Reese his Wife of the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Mesta Pope of the same County & State
 of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Sampson L. Reese and Mary his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy dollars current Money, of this Commenceth to them in hand paid by the said Mesta Pope at or before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, and each of them do hereby grant bargain and sell unto him the said Mesta Pope his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Lukes, containing by a late survey twenty acres (or the same, more or less) and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a maple standing in a small bush on a corner in said Sampson Reese's line, thence along the road, a new line North 71° E. 17 1/2 poles thence S 71° E 16 poles thence S. 80° E 28 3/4 poles to a pine on the corner for said Sampson Reese in Mesta Pope's line, thence along the said Mesta Pope's line S. 21° N. 7 poles to a pine on a corner, thence S 17 1/2° E. 9 poles to a white oak standing near a small branch, a corner for David Bryant, thence down the run of said small branch to the first branch, thence up the run of the said branch to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances unto him the said Mesta Pope his heirs and assigns forever (to use for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Mesta Pope his heirs and assigns forever) And the said Sampson L. Reese and Mary his wife, for themselves, their heirs Executors and assigns do hereby covenant and agree, to and with the said Mesta Pope his heirs Executors assigns and assigns, that they will by
