This Indenture made the 18th day of June in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty-six between Mary Griffen of the County of Isle of Wight of the one part, and Henry Jones of the County of Southampton and all of the State of Virginia, of the other part Winchester, that the said Mary Griffen in consideration of Ninety dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to her in hand paid by the said Henry Jones at or before the making, and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do and doth, bargain and sell unto the said Henry Jones a certain tract piece or parcel of Land lying and being in said County of Southampton containing thirty seven and half acres, be the same, more or less, and bounded by the Lands of Samuel Corbett, James Williams English, Joel Leavitt and Harry Lawrence, together with all the houses buildings, yards, gardens, orchards, lands, woods, profits, easements, commodities, advantages, emoluments, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging, or appertaining or with the same used and enjoyed or accepted reputed taken or known, as part parcel or member thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof, and the reversions and reversion, remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof.
