full payment as he or they or either of them may think proper on the said Uriah Raads, his heirs  
executors administrators or assigns shall request, sell the said tract of Land and premises with the ap-  
partances together with the said Negro man Slave named Cyprian or such part of the hereby granted  
premises as the trustee or his representative, hereby authorizes to act shall think sufficient for the purpose, and  
sell the same to the highest bidder, for ready money at public auction, after having paid the  
two and three pence of duty at his or their own discretion, and given ten days notice thereof at sundry pub-  
lic places in the neighbourhood previous to the day of sale, and out of the monies arising from such  
sale, after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the premises, pay to the said Uriah  
Raads his heirs executors administrators or assigns the said balance due on the note first herein mentioned  
and also the other notes to which he is bound as security aforesaid or such of them as may remain  
unpaid, to be applied to the payment of the same or such as may be unpaid, together with any inter-  
est which may have theron lawfully accrued, and the balance (if any) shall pay to the said Jacob Williams  
his heirs executors administrators or assigns. But if the whole of the said sum of money and interest shall be  
fully paid off and discharged when the same is payable or when they shall be severally demanded, so  
that no default of payment thereof shall be made and the said Uriah Raads his heirs execs. & assigns  
completely exonerated, acquitted and discharged of and from all and any loss damage and inconveni-  
ence which he or they shall or may sustain or incur by being bound as the security aforesaid, then  
the Indenture to be void, etc to remain in full force and virtue. In witness whereof the parties
