Story and Catharine his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars current money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said John Wilson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold alighted, unfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents do, and each of them with grant, bargain, sell, alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said John Wilson, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises, situate lying and be-
