Eighteen hundred and thirty-six, between Calvin Boydin of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part and Josiah Norrell of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth, that the said Calvin Boydin for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand three hundred dollars current money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Josiah Norrell at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Josiah Norrell his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Saint Lukes containing by a late survey, two hundred and sixty-eight acres (be the same, more or less) it being lots No 3 & 4 in the division of the Land of Calvin Boydin decd. as will appear by the report of the Commissioners who were appointed by a decree of the County Court of Southampton to divide the lands of said decd, and bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at a log post standing in the Arsons branch a corner for North S. Williams in Richd. Blunt decd. line formerly for Boydin's corner thence along said Williams line S 85° 0' E 112 1/2 poles to a log post (post standing) in Swamp thence down the Swamp to a black gum a corner, thence S 26° E 36 1/2 poles thence S 17 1/2 E 12 poles, thence S 21° E 7 poles to a hickory, thence S 70° N 18 poles to a red oak standing near the Cold river, thence up the Cold River to the new River a corner for sa. North S. Williams, thence down the Aaherring River to the mouth of the said cold River, Richd. Blunt decd. line thence up to said cold River to a cypress, thence N 68° E 16 poles thence N 80° E 16 poles, thence S 89° E 43 poles to a Birch, thence S 82° E 67 poles to a pine standing on the south east side of the little Swamp a corner in said Blunt's line thence up the said Swamp to three cypresses standing at the rear of said Swamp a corner for sa. Josiah Norrell's line thence along said Norrell's line N 87° N 238 poles to a white oak a corner thence N 31° N 110 1/2 poles to a post thence N 73° E 10 poles to a post thence across the Swamp N 19° N 26 1/2 poles to a post oak a corner in James Boydin Junr. line thence along said Boydin's line S 73° N 23 poles to a white oak, thence N 58° N 86 poles to a Maple a corner in said Richd.
