Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Griffen, Samuel A. Holmes, Cauds Bull, Robert Griffen, Sheriff Pick, Jesse Parker, Patrick Dolis, Lewis A. Branch, Clements Rachelle are held and firmly bound unto to Synaham Robertson Esq. Lieutenant Governor, acting as Governor, of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just sum of Thirty Thousand dollars to be paid to the said acting Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs executors & administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Witness with our seals and dates this 19. day of December 1836.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Benjamin Griffen is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the acting Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the 29th day of November 1836. If therefore the said Benjamin Griffen shall truly and faithfully collect, account for and pay the taxes imposed by law and arrears of taxes due in the said County of Southampton, and shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the Militia fines imposed by law and all arrears of Militia fines due in his County of Southampton then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
