 St. Governor, a full sum of Thirty Thousand dollars to be paid to the said acting Governor and his successors for the
 use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made, no bond canceled and each of
 us, our and each of our heirs executors & administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed
 with our seals and dated this 19. day of December 1836.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Benjamin Griffin is con-
 stituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the acting Governor
 under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 29th day of November 1836. If therefore the said Benjamin
 Griffin shall truly and faithfully collect, account for and pay the taxes imposed by law and arrears of taxes
 due in the said County of Southampton, and shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the
 militia fine imposed by law and all arrears of militia fine due in his County of Southampton then
 the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
