It is that the said Richard Mason and Mary Louisa his Wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Thousand, one hundred and twenty-five dollars, in hand paid by the said Edwards, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold, and by this presents as grant, bargain, alienation, in fee simple and confirm unto the said Peter Edwards, his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County & State aforesaid, containing one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three acres and bounded as follows, on the North by the lands of Mary Hells, on the East by the lands of James Jackson and the orphans of Absalom P. Smith, on the South by the Meherrin River, and on the west by the lands of Francis Risley being the land purchased by Stationer Mason and of Jane N. Blunt. To have and to hold the said tract of Land and premises with their and every of their appurtenances unto him the said Peter Edwards his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Richard Mason and Mary Louisa, his Wife, hereby covenant to and with the said Peter Edwards that they the said Mason & Wife their executors and administrators will warrant and forever defend the title to the above named tract of land and premises with their appurtenances unto the said Peter Edwards his heirs and assigns against themselves the said Richard Mason and Mary L. his Wife, their heirs and assigns and against the claim, title or demand of all and every other persons or persons whatsoever.
