Williams hath for & in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred & twenty-seven dollars & 50/100 to me in hand paid, bargained & sold and by these presents do bargain sell and convey to the said James Jackson my Mill, Measure, Piche &c also one acre of land on the south side of the Mill. And I, the said Williams, do warrant and defend the right of title to the said James Jackson, and bind myself my heirs executors and assigns, &c to warrant and defend the right of title to the said Jackson his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever. Ridley trustee aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Five thousand five hundred & one sole lawful money of the United States to him by the said James Jackson in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold & by these presents doth bargain, sell and convey unto the said James Jackson his heirs & assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, containing by estimation 1183 acres, to the same more or less, lying and being in the County of Southampton and known by the name of the West Plains and bounded as by reference to the said deeds will more fully appear. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said James Jackson his heirs & assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the said James Jackson his heirs & assigns forever. And the said R. Ridley for himself his heirs &c doth hereby covenant & agree to and with the sa. J. Jackson his heirs & assigns, that he the said R. Ridley & his heirs, the said, with its appurtenances, unto him the sa. James Jackson his heirs & assigns, against him the sa. R. Ridley & his heirs only, shall & will forever warrant & defend.
