 by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 16. day of Janey 1837.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Sarah M. Pond has  
 been duly appointed by the court of Southampton County to serve as constable within the said County  
 until July Court 1837, to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Shugars Lain. Now if  
 the said Sarah M. Pond shall well and truly discharge the duties of the said office of constable  
 in the said County, during his continuance therin, then this obligation to be void, or else to remain  
 in full force and virtue.

 the first part Jettison R. Edwards of the second part and Gormish Cobb of the third part, all  
 to the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that whereas the said Edmund Halcomb is justly indebted  
 to the said Gormish Cobb as guardian of Sally Briggs in the sum of two hundred and four dol-  
 lars with interest thence from the 1st day of January 1835, and the said Edmund Halcomb  
 being willing and anxious to secure the payment of the said debt and interest, hath for and in  
 consideration of the promises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar  
 to him in hand paid by the said Jettison R. Edwards at or before the sealing and delivery  
 of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given, granted, bargained & sold  
 and doth by these presents, give, grant, bargain & sell unto the said Jettison R. Edwards his heirs  
 Executors admoes & assigns, the following property to wit (as so much as remains after satisfying)  
 execution now in the hands of the Sheriff against the said Edmund Halcomb in favour of the  
 said Halcomb). All the said Halcombs undivided interest in the lands lying in Southampton  
 County, of which his father Richard Halcomb did die and possessed. Also one tract or  
 parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less  
 being the tract of lands purchased by the said Edmund Halcomb of Miles Scarborough and wife  
 Richenda Hone & wife of John Jones by Deed recorded in the County Court of Southampton on the 28th  
 day of August 1832, also one dark bay Mare, three Sons of 17 mds one Cow, one bed of furniture, some  
 pail & shells, 3 ploughs, three sets of traces, twenty barrels of corn of 2000 lbs fdder, 3 chairs, and
