This Indenture made this 24th day of January 1837 between Camuna Halcomb of the first part Lillian R. Edwards of the second part and Jeremiah Cobb of the third part, all of the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that whereas the said Camuna Halcomb is justly indebted to the said Jeremiah Cobb as guardian of Sally Briggs in the sum of two hundred and four dollars with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1835, and the said Camuna Halcomb being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the said debt and interest, hath for and in consideration of the promises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Lillian R. Edwards at or before the sealing, and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given, granted, bargained & sold unto the said Lillian R. Edwards his heirs executors admors & assigns, the following property to wit (or so much as remains after satisfying an execution now in the hands of the Sheriff against the said Camuna Halcomb in favour of Rich. and Halcomb) - All the said Halcombs undivided interest in the lands by way in Southampton County, of which his father Richard Halcomb died seized and possessed. Also one tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less being the tract of land purchased by the said Camuna Halcomb of Miles Scarborough and wife Richard Hones & wife & John Hones by Deed recorded in the County Court of Southampton on the 24th day of August 1832, also one dark bay Mare, three sows & 17 pigs one Cow, one he & furniture, some pots & kettles, 3 ploughs, three hoes & truses, twenty barrels of corn & 2000 lbs. fodder, 2 chairs, one
