This Indenture made this 30th day of November 1836 between Littleton R. Edwards of the one part and Martha B. Rochelle of the other part both of the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that the said Littleton R. Edwards for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred and twenty-five dollars to him in hand paid by said Martha B. Rochelle at or before the sealing and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted, bargained and sold and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell and confirm unto the said Martha B. Rochelle his heirs and assigns, two tracts or parcels of Land to wit, one tract containing five hundred and nineteen acres lying near Jerusalem, formerly belonging to the estate of James Rochelle deceased and which was purchased by the said James Rochelle of William J. Scott, and the other tract containing three hundred and thirty seven acres lying near Jerusalem formerly belonging to the estate of James Rochelle deceased and conveyed to the said James Rochelle by due form of Deeds left. To have and to hold the said tracts of Land together with the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Martha B. Rochelle his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of her the said Martha B. Rochelle her heirs and assigns forever. And the said Littleton R. Edwards for himself and his heirs hereby covenants, promises and agrees to and with the said Martha B. Rochelle in manner and form following that is to say that he the said Littleton R. Edwards and his heirs the said tracts or parcels of Land with the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Martha B. Rochelle his heirs and assigns against the claims of him the said Littleton R. Edwards and his heirs and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons, claiming by through or under him, but against the claim or claims of no other per-
