

This Indenture made This the 13th day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven, between John Hines & wife Martha of the County of Southampton of the one part  
 to and Miles Scarborough of the County of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth that the said  
 Scarborough John Hines & wife Martha, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, to them  
 in hand paid by the said Miles Scarborough, the receipt whereof the said John Hines & wife Martha  
 doth hereby acknowledge that they the said John Hines & wife Martha, have granted, bargained &  
 sold, alienated enfeoffed and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien enfeoffed and conform unto  
 the said Miles Scarborough his heirs & assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of Land contain-  
 ing nearly eight acres, to be the same more or less situated, lying and being in the County of Southamp-  
 ton and bounded by the Lands of Eli Baker, Temperance Bikes and Littleberry Jones, as being the  
 Land whereon the said John Hines formerly resided; to have and to hold all and singular the said  
 premises aforementioned with every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Miles Scarborough,  
 his heirs & forever: and the said John Hines and wife Martha for them and their heirs, the said  
 tract of Land and every part thereof, against themselves and their heirs and against all and every  
 person whatsoever to the said Miles Scarborough his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and  
 forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof the said John Hines and wife, Martha, have  
 hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above written.

 them in hand paid by the said Gibelton L. Simmons at or before the making and delivery of  
 these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said William J. Sobell &  
 Virginia his wife have bargained & sold, and by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said  
 Gibelton L. Simmons and his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land with  
 its appurtenances lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid, being a part of the  
 land formerly owned by Capt. Daniel Butts, sold at his sale and purchased by the said William  
 J. Sobell, containing ten and 1/4 acres and bounded as follows to wit So by the land (a part  
 of the aforesaid tract) of Daniel W. Simmons, N by the lands of Gibelton L. Simmons, S by the  
 lands of William J. Sobell, a part of the said tract and E by the lands of Joseph W. C.  
 together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, the reversion and reversions, remainder and remain-
