This Indenture made the 19th day of January in the year of our Lord eight hundred and thirty seven between Benjamin L. Drew acting as Trustee in a certain Deed of Trust bearing date the 6th day of Decr. 1823 executed by John Warren & wife, to the said Drew as Trustee for the benefit of Ruffin Hart of the County of Southampton of the one part and Allen Stephenson of the said County of the other part. Whereas that the said Benjamin L. Drew, as Trustee, as aforesaid, having advertisement and sold the said seven and one half acres of Land expressed in said Deed of Trust, agreeably to the provisions of said Deed for one hundred and thirty eight dollars, and the said Allen Stephenson became the purchaser for the sum aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Trustee) has bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Allen Stephenson his heirs and assigns all the right rectile in me, as trustee, in the aforesaid Land known by the name of Buck Horn, and more particularly described in the Deed of trust aforesaid and the reversion and the reversions, remainders and remainders, yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof: To have and to hold the said 6 1/2 acres of land with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular thing the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their right, members and appurtenances, unto the said Allen Stephenson, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Benjamin L. Drew as Trustee, as aforesaid, for himself & his heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned, unto the said Allen Stephenson his heirs and assigns, free from him or the claim of him the said Benjamin L. Drew, as Trustee, as aforesaid, his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatever claiming by, through or under him, as trustee aforesaid. In witness whereof the said Benjamin L.
