This Indenture, made this sixteenth day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty
 six, between Benjamin Lewis of the County of Southampton of the one part and James Mason of the County
 of Sussex of the other part, both of the state of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Lewis for and
 in consideration of the sum of two thousand six hundred and thirty nine dollars and twenty five cents lawful
 money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James Mason at or before the inscaling and ac-
 knowledgment of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold & conveyed and by these
 presents do bargain sell & convey unto the said James Mason his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel
 of Land, situated lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by recent survey six hundred and
 twenty one acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows viz beginning at a Maple at corner on John C.
 Masons line, thence along his line N 28° E 12 poles, N 10° E 9 poles to a spine on the Road thence along
 the said Road as it meanders to David Bomer's line thence along his line S 81 1/2° E 112 1/2 poles to a spine S
 43° E 77 poles to a spine at corner to Lewis Morris' land thence along his line S 85° West 34 poles S 41°
 N 66 poles S 25° E 7 1/2 poles S 43° N 34 poles S 45° N 13 1/2 poles to a new oak, S 9° E 117 poles to an
 old stump on the Shore brook, thence up the said brook as it meanders to an overcup white oak as corner
 to John C. Mason, thence along his line due North 31 poles to a poplar gum on Masons Mill Swamp thence
 up the said Swamp as it meanders to the beginning, together with all and singular the appurtenances and premises
 and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders great and then rents, issues and profits thereof and
 of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of Land and premises with the ten-
 ements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bar-
 gained and sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights, members and appurtenances
 unto the said James Mason his heirs or assigns forever. And the said Benjamin Lewis for himself, and
 his heirs, the said tract of Land with all and singular the appurtenances and premises before mentioned
 unto the said James Mason his heirs and assigns, free from the claim or claims of him the said Ben-
 jamin Lewis and his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall well and so
