This Indenture, made this sixth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, b.  
Allen Edwards of the one part, Commissioner appointed by the Court for that purpose, and Matthew Wells, the  
purchaser of the other part. Whereas, that the said Allen Edwards commissioner sold to the highest bidder for the  
sum of Twelve hundred and seventy six dollars of Lawfull money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by  
the said Matthew Wells at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do sell unto the said Matthew Wells his heirs and  
assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing about three hundred acres be the same more or less and  
bounded as follows, beginning at a black gum in the Coggs Swamp a corner tree between the said and Thomas
