This Indenture made this twenty first day of July one thousand eight hundred and thirty six between Benjamin Travis and Elizabeth Travis his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part, Herbert Lanier of the said County of the other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin Travis and wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty six dollars to him in hand paid by the sd. Herbert Lanier the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Travis and wife do hereby acknowledge he the said Benjamin Travis and wife hath granted bargained and sold aliende and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, alow and conform unto the sd. Herbert Lanier one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation twelve acres, to the same more or less and bounded by the lands of John Fletcher (on Brown's Road) W. D. Morris and by the said Benjamin Travis on the new Road leading from Barrett's Milling house to John Fletcher's gate, (said road being the line); and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents and services of the said premises and every part thereof and also the estate right title interest, claim and demand whatsoever of him the sd. Benjamin Travis & wife of, in and to the same premises and every part thereof to have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned of every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Herbert Lanier his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Benjamin Travis and wife, for themselves their heirs &c the said lands and premises and every part thereof against them and their heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend unto the said Herbert Lanier his heirs and assigns forever. This Indenture made and executed this 20th day of February 1837 between Samuel R Gardner & Nancy Gardner & wife his wife of the first part and Edward L. Crumpler of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and state of New Hampshire that the said Samuel R Gardner and Nancy his wife have, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty two dollars and fifty cents to them in hand, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, bargained and sold and so by these presents bargained and sold aliende and conform unto the said Edward L. Crumpler, one certain tract and parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by survey thirty two and 1/2 acres and bounded as follows beginning at a small oak tree a new corner between this tract and Samuel R Gardner in a line between Monck's Hollands and Samuel R Gardner, thence S 73° E 18 ft along the line between this tract and Monck's Hollands to a pine thence N 70° E 37 ft 17 links along the old line between this tract and Edward Crumpler to a pine at Edward L. Crumpler's gate thence N 73° W 139 ft 18 links along the old line between this tract and Edward L. Crumpler to a pine thence S 67° W 26 ft to a dead pine, thence S 88° W 20 ft to a small oak at corner of Bob Hardy brook and a new corner of this tract and Sam. R. Gardner (the original corner is an old gunn stump near the small oak) thence S 10½° E 126 poles along a new line of marker trees between this tract and Samuel R Gardner to the beginning. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with every part and parcel thereof and thereunto belonging, with all the reversion or reversions or remainder or remainders yearly and other rents forever and the said Samuel R Gardner and Nancy his wife do for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators, hereby warrant and forever defend the aforesaid premises. Free from all the claim or claims, demands or encumbrances of all and every person whomsoever invasions, whereby we the parties have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this day and year as before written.
