Jenkins & Jennett L. his Wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell convey & confirm unto the said Peter D. Buckman his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of Land, situate & being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and bounded as follows by the lands of Spratly Williams, Thomas Kelly and others and estimated to contain twenty five acres more or less it being the same tract of Land known as "Long Line" which Jno. McCreary seized and possessed together with all & singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, it here and to hold the above described premises unto the said Peter D. Buckman his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Jesse J. Cox & Georgiana his Wife, Geo. M. F. Dashiell & Elizabeth his Wife & Jethro A. Jenkins & Jennett L. his Wife the aforesaid premises unto the said Peter D. Buckman his heirs & assigns, against the claims & claims of all and every person whomsoever so and will warrant and forever defend by their persons. In Witness whereof the said Jesse J.
