mon and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Nelson B. Gardner and Unity his wife for an consideration of the sum of Two hundred & eighty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Hardy Croft, at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said Nelson B. Gardner and Unity his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents both and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Hardy Croft, his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land being and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of the heirs of Noah W. Gardner, Alfred Cobb and the said Hardy Croft, marked and bounded as follows, beginning at a pine standing in Alfred Cobb's line a corner of the said Croft's line thence a straight line of marked trees to a gum in the people Branch thence up the several courses of the run to a gum in the said Branch a corner thence a straight line of marked trees along the lane to a stake in the aforesaid Croft's line thence along the said Croft's line to the first station, containing Seventy two and a half acres to the same more or less, the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Hardy Croft his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Nelson B.
