Witnesseth that the said Philip I. blaud for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five dollars of lawful money, to him in hand paid by the said Joseph I. blaud at or before the executing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Philip I. blaud have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell makes over and conform unto the sd. Joseph I. blaud his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land situated and lying in the sd. County and known as the residence of the said John blaud containing seventy acres, be the same more or less, and adjoining the Lands of the sd. Joseph I. blaud & Benjamin Mallett. This Indenture made this 11th day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty seven between Robert S. Barnes (trustee) of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part and Josiah Horrell of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Robert S. Barnes (trustee) by virtue of a deed of trust executed to him by John Story of the aforesaid County of Southampton, bearing date on the 31st day of January Eighteen hundred and thirty two, for certain purposes therein mentioned; and duly recorded in the Clerk's office of the aforesaid County (after giving legal notice of the time and place of sale) hath sold at public auction to the highest bidder for cash the said John Story interest in the tract of Land wherein he resides and the said Josiah Horrell became the purchaser for the sum of thirty dollars. In consideration of the above sum of thirty dollars in hand paid to the said Robert S. Barnes by the said Josiah Horrell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert S. Barnes both granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Josiah Horrell his heirs and assigns forever all the said John Story's right or interest in the aforesaid tract of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Saint Luke containing fifty two & 3/4 acres (be the same more or less) & being said Story's share in right of his wife of the land of Jordan Vick dec'd and bounded by the lands of said Josiah Horrell Lewis Nick & others.
