This Indenture made and entered into on this 13th day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty seven, between George S. Whidbee of the first part, James D. Bryant (Trustee) of the second part, and John Hargrave & Tho^s B. Norrell of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said George S. Whidbee is justly indebted to the said John Hargrave by bond bearing date with these presents for the sum of fifty-two dollars seventy six & half cents, and to the said Tho^s B. Norrell by bond bearing date with these presents for fifty-two dollars seventy six and half cents, and he the said George S. Whidbee being willing and desirous to secure the payment of said debt to them the said John Hargrave & Tho^s B. Norrell, together with the interest thereon accruing: Hath for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James D. Bryant at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto him, the said James D. Bryant his heirs and assigns, the following property to wit one Saddle Tree, one saddle & bridle, two feather bed bedsteads and furniture, one blue chest, one safe, four sitting chairs, one iron pot, one table, one axe, 2 baskets, 1 bundle, one spinning wheel, one knife box, 2 tubs, one water spout, 2 old wood boxes, 1 goul Hoe, and all any part of my crop to be made the present year on said Tho^s B. Norrell's land, consisting of corn, fodder, peas, cotton and potatoes. To have and to hold the above named property and future crop hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted unto him the said James D. Bryant his heirs executors assigns and assigns forever. And the said George S. Whidbee for himself, his heirs, executors and assigns doth hereby covenant bargain and agree to and with the said James D. Bryant his heirs, executors assigns and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title to the aforesaid property and future crop against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever to and for the following intent use and purposes WIT - Upon Special Trust nevertheless, that the said James D. Bryant or his legal representatives shall permit the said George S. Whidbee to remain in quiet and peaceful possession of all the aforesaid property until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid debt either in whole or in part - and at any time after the happening of such default of payment, when he shall be requested by either the said George S. Whidbee or John Hargrave and Tho^s B. Norrell or their representatives the said James D. Bryant or his legal representatives after giving reasonable notice of this time and place of sale shall sell at public auction for cash all the aforesaid property and future crop hereby conveyed and out of the moneys arising from such sale after paying all costs attending the execution of these presents, pay to the said John Hargrave and Tho^s B. Norrell the amount of the aforesaid debt and interest and the balance of any pay to said George S. Whidbee his order or assigns.
