Pope the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the said Richard Darden and Nancy Darden his wife hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William B. Pope a certain tract of Land containing thirty one acres by the same more or less and bounded on the North by the Land of William Pope, on the East by that of Benjamin Edwards formerly, on the south by that of Benjamin Blunt, on the West by the Land of Benjamin Blunt also it being the Land called Burnell Jones Land, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the said tract of Land unto the said William B. Pope his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Richard Darden for himself his heirs and assigns doth warrant and defend the title of said Land. This Intenture made and entered into this 20th day of March in the year 1837 between Francis Rochelle of the one part and Edward Baton of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Now therefore this intenture witnesseth that the said Francis Rochelle for and in consideration of one hundred & ninety dollars to her in hand paid by the said Edward Baton at or before sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward Baton his heirs and assigns forty and one eighth acres of Land it being a part of the tract of two hundreds and eighty two acres conveyed by Nathaniel Rochelle to William R. Edwards for the benefit of Stephen Murchough and others by the said Littleton R. Edwards and at the said Francis Rochelle became the purchaser, and bounded as follows, to wit Beginning at a hickory standing on Hopkins Road a corner for John A. Turner in William D. Phillips line thence along the said Turners line No. 72 N 6° E 6 poles to swedgum thence N 70° E 51 poles to a white oak thence N 69° W 38 poles to a white oak thence N 68° E 30 to a red oak thence N 71° E 6 poles to a corner for said James in A. Middleton's line thence along said Middletons line No. 20 N 11° E 6 poles to a black gum standing in a large branch a new corner thence a new line of Market trees N 86° E 146 poles to said Boykin road another new corner thence along said Road S 18° E 13 poles thence S 16 W 50 poles thence S 26 W 13 poles to the beginning to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land together with every part and parcel thereof unto them the said Edward Baton his heirs and assigns to the only profit and behove of him he had Edward Baton his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Francis Rochelle hereby conveys to and with the said Edward Baton that he will warrant and forever defend the right and title of the premises forty and one eighth acres of Land and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Edward Baton his heirs and assigns against himself the said Francis Rochelle his heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons lawfully by, through or under her, but against no other person or persons whomsoever.
