This Indenture made and entered into this 22d day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Henry Hindress of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Humphrey Dwry of the said County and State of the other part. Whereas that for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the sd. Hindress, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents agreed between and sold unto the sd. Dwry all his right title & interest in a certain piece or parcel of land lying in the said County and by a recent survey containing) eighteen acres it being a part of the land (in the division of Harris Johnson lands) settled William Harrison and wife, which was sold by the sheriff of said County for arrearages of taxes, to which the said Hindress became purchaser of - now the said Hindress conveys unto such title as is vested in him by such sale and purchase, but such is intended to be conveyed unto the said Dwry his heirs and assigns from agt. the claim of any other person or persons whatsoever. This Indenture, made this 23d day of March 1837, between Samuel M. Pond, trustee of the one part and John Cram of the other part. Whereas Robert Cram, by indenture of trust bearing date the 2d day of October 1826 conveyed to William Ricks, trustee for John Cram, in trust for purposes thereina mentioned, the following land, to wit, lying on the east side of Round Hill adjoining the bridge and bounded on the south by the Sandfield Road, on the north by Patrick Pond's land containing) fifty acres more or less, with all the interest, right, title claim or demand of the above mentioned property. And whereas at a court held for the County of Southampton the 21st day of November 1836 (the said William Ricks having reported this day) the said Samuel M. Pond was appointed trustee to carry into effect the provisions of said deed; and whereas the said Samuel M. Pond, in pursuance thereto having given notice as directed by said deed, did on the 1st day of December 1836 expose to sale at public auction the land and premises above mentioned when the said John Cram became the purchaser thereof for the sum of twenty five dollars. Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Samuel M. Pond trustee as aforesaid in consideration of the premises & of the said sum of Seventy five dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Cram, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Samuel M. Pond has bargained and sold and by these presents with bargain & sell unto the said John Cram the before mentioned tract or parcel of land and every part & parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and every part & parcels thereof unto him the said John Cram his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Samuel M. Pond trustee as aforesaid hereby covenants to and with the said John Cram to warrant & defend the right and title of the said land against himself his heirs and assigns and against all and every person or persons claiming under him, but against the claims & demands of no other persons whatsoever.
