This Indenture made the 20th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven, between Roda McClenney, James her son & Minney his wife of the one part and Harry
Hardy of the other part all of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia - Witnesseth that for
and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Harry
Hardy at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they
the said Roda McClenney, James her son & Minney his wife have granted bargained and sold & by these pre-
sents as of right of them both grant bargains & sell unto the said Harry Corp his heirs & assigns a certain
tract or parcel of land lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & being on the West side
of Blackwater River marked and bounded as follows beginning at the mouth of Roane; thence
the various courses of the river to a large pine corner of Harry Corp in Edwards Crumpler line thence
along a line of marked trees to a small white oak corner of Harry Corp in Elizabeth Johnson line
thence along a line of marked trees to a large pine corner of J. J. Williams in Elizabeth Johnsons line,
thence a straight line of marked trees to the first station containing one hundred and twenty three and $\frac{3}{4}$
acres more or less. The reservation & reversion remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues
and profits thereof & every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel
of Land with the appurtenances thereto and all other singular the promises and appurtenances before
mentioned unto the said Harry Corp his heirs & assigns forever. and the said Roda McClenney, James
McClenny her son and Minney his wife for themselves & their heirs the said tract or parcel with the prom-
ises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Harry Corp his heirs & assigns free from all claims
or demands left them by said Roda McClenney, James, his son & Minney his wife or either of them there. Their
or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons, whatsoever, shall will and do warrant and
recover before by these presents. I, Mr. McBlennens Clerk of the said Roda McClenney, James her son and Minney his wife
have hereunto set their hands and seals this day of year as first above written.
