This Indenture made and entered into on this 15th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven by and between Allen Bryant, James D. Bryant and Jacob Barnes, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. This Indenture witnesseth that the said Allen Bryant in order to secure to the said Jacob Barnes the payment of fifty eight dollars and eighty nine cents justly due the said Jacob Barnes by him with even date herewith with interest and costs of drawing this indenture and carrying the same into effect, and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Allen Bryant in hand paid by the said James D. Bryant at or before the execution and delivery of these presents whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Allen Bryant hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said James D. Bryant the following property to wit: Two feather beds and furniture, 3 Chests, 2 Tables, 5 sitting Chairs, 1 spinning wheel, one loom & were 16 pieces of toiles, 6 Spoons, 2 Spots. One acre, one hatched squirrel gun. 2 hats, 2 bell, 1 piece of earthen ware, one pair of iron tracery. One格里 iron & single bar and all the right little interest and estate whatsoever of and unto the above named property of every parcel of the above named property to him the said James D. Bryant his heirs and assigns forever. To have and to hold the said property unto the said James D. Bryant his heirs and assigns. Upon trust nevertheless that the said Jas. D. Bryant at the request of either of the above named parties shall as soon as conveniently he can after having advertised the time and place of the sale of the above named property ten days previous thereto at three or more public places in S^t County proceed to sell the same for cash and out of the money arising therefrom first pay all reasonable charges attending the sale and then satisfy the debt interest and costs above named, and the residue of money arising from such sale to be paid to the said Allen Bryant or his order his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns.
