This Indenture made this 23rd day of March in the year of our Lord Christ eighteen hundred and thirty seven. Between Mills Giffen & Elizabeth Giffen his wife of the one part and Benjamin H Giffen of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of New York Metropole. that the said Mills Giffen and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of forty dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin H Giffen at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents to, and each of them with her joint and sole unto the said Henry H Giffen his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land and premises lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation seven and one half acres more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at a gun a corner tree of lot M Cluny, John Harris and William Atkinson, thence a line of marked trees along Atkinsons line to a willow oak, a corner, thence a line of marked trees to a post oak, a corner on the poor house land M Cluny and John Harris Wardland, thence a line of marked trees to the beginning, together with all and singular the houses, out houses, edifices, buildings, yards, gardens, ways, water and water courses, profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said $\frac{7}{8}$ acres of land belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same, reserving at the same time the life rights of the said Mills & Elizabeth Giffins in and to the said parcel of land, that is, that they are to remain on it and use that part they can cultivate, and at their death or removal from said land, then the whole right and title to descend to the said Benjamin H Giffen and his heirs forever with every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land & premises unto the said Benjamin H Giffen his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and benefit of him the said Henry H Giffen his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Mills Giffen & Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises hereinbefore mentioned reserving their life rights as before described, unto the said Benjamin H Giffen his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Mills & Elizabeth Giffins (reserving their life rights in the same) their $\frac{1}{2}$ and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. This Indenture made this 22nd day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Benjamin H Giffen son of Mills Giffen of the County of Southampton and State of New York of the one part and John Harris of the same County and State of the other part, Metropole, that the said Benjamin H Giffen for the consideration of the sum of forty five dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said John Harris, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, exchanged and confirmed; and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Harris to him and to his heirs forever, all my right title and interest claims or demands which I have in the lands of Mills Giffen wheresoever situated, which land was conveyed to me by the said Mills Giffen by virtue of a Deed in the County Court of Southampton as will fully appear by reference thereto which land is situate in the County and State aforesaid. Containing by estimation Eight and one half acres better and bounded as follows. To wit, Beginning at a black gum about of William Atkinson, thence to a post oak, a corner of the poor house land, and thence to M Cluny, thence lands to water oak a corner on poor house land and so forth.
