This Indenture made this 19th day of June 1837 between Barney Asher and Rebecca his wife of the County of Norfolk and State of North Carolina of the one part and Norfest Cutler of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Barney Asher and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of a bond executed by Norfest and William Cutler to the said Barney Asher for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars dated the 1st day of April 1837 and payable twelve months after date, hath granted bargained sold and conveyed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Norfest Cutler his heirs or assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing seventy five acres or the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded by the Lands of William Barnes & Temperance Novell and known as a part of Nathan Williamses tract of Land which was allotted to the said Rebecca as her proportion of said tract. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Norfest Cutler his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Barney Asher and Rebecca his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators, doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Norfest Cutler his heirs and assigns that they the said Barney Asher and Rebecca his wife for themselves their heirs executors and assigns, doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Norfest Cutler his heirs and assigns that they the said Barney Asher and Rebecca his wife and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto him the said Norfest Cutler, and his heirs and assigns against them the said Barney Asher and Rebecca his wife and their heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and will by these presents forever warrant and defend.
