This Indenture made this 18th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty
seven between Jacob Senow of the one part and Thomas J. Brister of the other part both of the County of Southampton
and state of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Jacob Senow for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred &
fifteen dollars to him in hand paid or occurs to be paid by the said Thomas J. Brister the receipt whereof he
hereby acknowledge myself fully satisfied and of the same with by these presents acquit the said Thomas Brister
he the said Jacob Senow hath granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirms unto the said Thomas J. Brister and his heirs forever one cer-
tain tract or parcel of Lands lying and being in the County aforesaid which was given to me by my father
Benry Senow such in his last Will & Testament reference to which will more fully and at large appertain
beginning by estimation four hundred and ninety two acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
line to a dogwood a corner tree in Wiley Milens line thence a South course along said Milens line to two white
oaks near a branch thence up said branch a Southwest course crossing the road to a pine near a round pond
thence a line of marked trees to a white oak a corner thence in Mills Broadshaws line thence and east course
along said Broadshaws line to a pine then making a bend a South course along said Broadshaws line to a pine
a corner tree in Benjamin Clifflins line thence and east course along said Clifflins line to a white oak a
corner tree in Allen Edwards line thence a North course along said Edwards line to a steeping post oak a
corner tree in Samuel Brannetts line thence along said Brannetts line a cross the road to a white oak a corner
tree in James Senow line in Sarah's branch thence down the said branch to the black gum first mentioned thence
(belonging) or in any wise appertaining with reversion and reversions, remainder and remainder sons heirs and profits
thence and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances
