Turner at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John A. Turner and Martha his wife have given granted and sold and by these presents as give, grant, bargains and sells unto the said Dawson Brat his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and containing by estimation one hundred and eighty five acres be the same more or less and bounded by the Boykin road on the east by the lands of Nathaniel T. Williams on the south by the lands belonging to the estate of Rubin Middleton on the West and by the lands of the estate of Nathaniel Rockelle on the North being the lands allotted to him under out of the lands of the estate of Lawrence Cooks aforesaid. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto him the said Dawson Brat his heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit of him the said Dawson Brat his heirs and assigns forever. And the said John A. Turner and Martha his wife hereby covenant with the said Dawson Brat that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto him the said Dawson Brat against the claim and demands of themselves the said John A. Turner & Martha his wife and against the claim and demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said John A.
