This Indenture made and entered into the 21st day of June 1837 between John M. Gurley of the first part and Miss Joyner and Sally his wife of the other part all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents with grant bargain and sell a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and eighteen acres more or less & bounded by the Lands of Miles Scarborough, William Briggs & others it being the same land which Benj. Griffin sold as the Executor of Benjamin Williams decd. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the aforesaid Miss Joyner during ^{her} life but it is not to be subject to any debt which he may now owe or hereafter contract nor shall he have any power to sell any part during his life or otherwise, but if he should survive his wife in that case he is to enjoy the profits thereof during his life. The said John M. Gurley by these presents with hereby convey all his right title and interest in and to, unto the aforesaid Sally Joyner the wife of Miss Joyner aforesaid to have and her heirs forever and he the said John M. Gurley for himself and his heirs with warrant and forever defend the title of the said tract of Land unto the aforesaid Sally Joyner & her heirs against the claim or claims of all every person or persons whatsoever.
