This Indenture made and entered into this 11. day of June one Thousand eight hundred & thirty seven in and between Jacob J. Williams of Southampton County, & State of Virginia of the first part & Jesse Barker of the County and State of the said first part & Seth D. Williams of the same County and State of the said first part Witnesseth that whereas the said Jacob J. Williams stands justly indebted to the said Jesse Barker as shown by the said note bearing date 11. day of March one Thousand eight hundred & thirty five also one note for thirty five dollars made payable to the said Jesse Barker bearing date this 1st day of June one Thousand eight hundred & thirty seven payable from said also one in favour of Seth D. Williams for the sum of ninety two dollars & thirty eight cents bearing date this 14. day of June one Thousand eight hundred & thirty seven Now the said Jacob J. Williams being desirous to indemnify & secure the payment of the above debts, but more especially for the sum of one dollar to him the said Jacob J. Williams in hands paid by the said Seth D. Williams, for (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) the endorsing and delivery of these presents. By that the said J. J. Williams hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell to the said Seth D. Williams his heirs and assigns the following property forever to wit, 1 negro woman named Knapp, 2 horse, big and small, six head and furniture 1 cupboard & bureau, 1 large mantle place & clock, 1 set of dinner & 2 cooking chairs, 1 Mahogany handstand & Table, 1 set Blacksmith tools, all my farming utensils seven head cattle, corn, fodder &c all my growing crop of corn fodder, peas potatoes &c and all my other property not mentioned in this deed to him the said Seth D. Williams on trust to wit that if the said J. J. Williams shall fail to pay and discharge the above debts and all cost pertaining to this trust it shall be lawful and right in that case for him the said Seth D. Williams as soon as requested in writing by him the said Jesse Barker his heirs or assigns to sell of and sell for cash the above property after giving public notice by advertisement to be set up at different places in the neighborhood of the said J. J. Williams at least fifteen days previous to the day of sale, and if by the force of said sale first pay the above debts and cost pertaining to this trust and the overplus if any to be paid to him the said J. J. Williams his heirs or assigns. In testimony of which we the parties have hereunto set of hands & seals this 11th day of June Anno domini. 1837.

Know all men by these presents that we James D. Bryant, Lewis Norrell and Josiah Norrell are heirs and joint owners unto Lewis Campbell Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of Two Thousand to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Governor and his Successor for the use of the Commonwealth we the Governor bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators, jointly and severally solemnly by these presents. In witness whereof we have signed this 17th day of July 1837.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James D. Bryant has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as Constable within the lower district of St. Lukes Parish in the said County for the term of two years from the date hereof. Now if the said James D. Bryant shall well and truly discharge the duties of the office of Constable within the said district during his continuance in office then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force of virtue.
