

Know all men by these presents that we Jeremiah Stephenson, Nathan Pope & David Stevens are herein
and firmly bound unto David Campbell Esq Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum
of Two Thousand dollars, to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Governor and his successors for the
sum or value of the Commonwealth, we bind ourselves our heirs executors & administrators jointly and severally firmly by these
presents sealed with our seals and dated this 17th day of July 1837.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Jeremiah Stephenson has been duly ap-
pointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as constable within the upper district of St Lukes parish
in the said County for the term of two years from the date hereof. Now if the said Stephenson shall will and
truly discharge the duties of the office of constable within said district during his continuance therein then this ob-
ligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.

This Indenture made this 18th day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred Thirty three between
Arthur M. Holloman trustee to a certain deed and Trust made to him by Arthur Holloman, to secure to Silas Summerville, the
payment of certain sums of money therin mentioned, for which the said Summerville was said Holloman's security, as will
more fully appear by reference to said deed, which is of record in the Clerk's Office of the County court of Southham-
pton, of the one part and Arthur Holloman of the other part. Witnesseth that the above named Arthur M. Holloman,
trustee as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and two dollars to him in hand paid
or secured to be paid Silas Summerville at or before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath bargained & sold and by these presents hath bargained & sold unto the said Silas C.
Summerville, all the right title and interest conveyed to him by Arthur Holloman in the above named deed of trust
to a certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton, known by the name of Capt. Arthur
Holloman's old place it being the same which he had from the heirs of his brother Eason Holloman supposed to contain four
hundred acres but the same more or less and bounded by the Lands of the said Arthur Holloman John Williamson John
Morgan and John S. Gwatney with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appur-
tenant. To have and to hold the said Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the
privileges herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of
the rights members and appurtenances unto the said Silas C. Summerville his heirs and assigns forever, and the said
Arthur M. Holloman trustee, as aforesaid and his heirs the said Land with all and singular the appurtenances be-
fore mentioned unto the said Silas C. Summerville his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of him the
said Arthur M. Holloman trustee as aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever and all and every other person or per-
son whatsoever shall will and as warrant and power defend all the right title and interest in him as trustee to
said deed in trust and no more to him the said Silas C. Summerville his heirs and assigns forever by these pre-
sents. So witness whereof the said Arthur M. Holloman trustee, as aforesaid, hath hereunto set his hand and
seal this day year first above written.
