

This Indenture made this 31st day of July in the year of our Lord 1837 between Thomas Johnson and Mason his wife of the first part and Thomas C Jones and James H. Sobrell of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Johnson & Wife for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jones & Sobrell, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Thomas Johnson & Wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant and sell unto the said Thomas C Jones and James H. Sobrell one certain tract of land in the County of Southampton lying on Happy Run Swamp and bounded on the south by the lands belonging to the estate of Jack Maddie and on the east by lands of Jeremiah Hilliford and on the north by those of Samuel Wallace, together with the following personal property, to wit: One Horse, Six heads of cattle, twenty-four hogs fifteen sheep, two carts and wheels Cedar bush and the following utensils being of all kinds, four beds, tables, chairs and other furniture in the house together with the revision and reversions, remainder and remainders rents and appurtenances to the said land belonging or in any wise affording with every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said and personal property above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof to them the said Thomas C Jones and James H. Sobrell their heirs and assigns forever, and the said Thomas Johnson for himself his heirs and assigns the said tract of land and personally above mentioned and the said Thomas C Jones and James H. Sobrell their and assigns, both hereby warrant the title thereto to them against the claim of him the said Johnson & Wife and against the claim of all and every person whatsoever. Witnesseth that the said Thomas C Jones & Martha D. Ingram his wife and James H. Sobrell for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to them in hand paid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Martha D. Ingram and her heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land lying in the county aforesaid on Happy Run Swamp (containing) by estimation no less than forty acres and bounded on the south by the lands belonging to the estate of Jack Maddie and on the west by those of Jeremiah Hilliford and on the north by those of Samuel Wallace it being the tract of land lately purchased by said T. C. Jones & J. H. Sobrell of Thomas Johnson with the revision & reversions, remainder and remainders rents and profits thereof. To have and to hold to the said Martha D. Ingram her heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas C Jones and James H. Sobrell for themselves their heirs and assigns hereby warrant and defend the title of the aforesaid tract of one hundred acres fifty acres of land to the said Martha D.
