In Indenture made This fifth day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred & thirty seven between Richard Griffon Begain & Martha A. Begain his wife, Davis Dunlop Boydon & Ann A. Boydon his wife, John A. Selden & Maria A. Selden his wife, Miles C. Selden & Harriet C. Selden his wife, Mrs. A. Selden & Sarah A. Selden his wife, Flemming A. Miles & Elizabeth A. Miller his wife, John J. Saunders & Martha B. Saunders his wife & Carter H. Edsel of the first part, and William L. Rawlings of the second part: Whereas the late Mr. Allen of Surry, by his last Will & Testament duly recorded in the County Court of Surry bequeathed "to his Nephews & nieces in equal portion share & share alike all his lands and plantations in the County of Southampton" and whereas his nieces & nephews are Mary A. Osborne the wife of Nathaniel Osborne of Cumberland County, Martha A. Begain the wife of Mr. Begain of Surry County, Ann A. Boydon the wife of Davis Boydon of Petersburg, the John A. Selden of Charles City, said Miles C. Selden of Brooklands said Ann A. Selden of Charles City, said Elizabeth A. Miller the wife of Mr. T. B. Miller of Botetourt, Martha B. Saunders the wife of said John Saunders of Norfolk & Carter H. Edsel of Prince George each entitled to one undivided ninth part that Mr. Osborne & wife by acts dated the say of 1833 & duly recorded in the County Court of Surry aforesaid have conveyed to Mr. Griffon Begain the share or ninth part to which the sd Mrs. Mary A. Brown was entitled so that now the sd R. Griffon Begain & wife are entitled to two ninths: and Whereas the said Begain & wife have agreed to sell to the said Rawlings their two undivided ninth parts for the sum of three thousand dollars & the sd Begain & wife have agreed to sell him their one ninth part for the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars, and said John A. Selden & wife have agreed to sell him their ninth part for a like sum of fifteen hundred Dollars, and so Miles C. Selden & wife have agreed to sell him their ninth part for the sum of one thousand dollars, and so Mr. T. B. Miller & wife have agreed to sell him their ninth part for a like sum, and said Carter H. Edsel has agreed to sell his ninth part to the said Rawlings for a like sum: This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sums of money aforesaid by the said Rawlings to the said parties or their heirs respectively paid that is to say, to the said Begain & wife of 3000: to said Boydon & wife of 1500: to sa. John A. Selden & wife of 1500 to said Miles C. Selden & wife of 1500: to said Ann A. Selden & wife of 1500: to the sd T. B. Miller & wife of 1500: to the sd Saunders & wife of 1500: & to the sd C. H. Edsel of 1500: the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they the said Begain & wife, Boydon & wife, John A. Selden & wife, Miles C. Selden & wife, Ann A. Selden & wife, Miller & wife, Saunders & wife & C. H. Edsel have bargained & sold aforesaid unfeoffed & confirmed & they do by these presents bargain & sell, alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said Rawlings the interest or undivided shares & portions by them severally held as aforesaid in & to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton & bequeathed by the late Mr. Allen aforesaid by his last Will & Testament (now or late) six thousand four hundred & forty eight acres & bounded as follows to wit: on the North by the lands of on the East by the Notoway River, on the South by the lands of on the West by the lands of including all the lands & plantations lying & being in the County of Southampton of which the late Mr. Allen aforesaid by his will bequeathed by him as herein before recited, together with all & singular the advantages & appurtenances unto the same belonging or in any wise appertaining: to have & hold the same, unto the sd Rawlings his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever to him for his & their only service & behoof. And the said Begain & wife, Boydon & wife, John A. Selden & wife, Miles C. Selden & wife, Ann A. Selden & wife, Miller & wife, Saunders & wife & C. H. Edsel for themselves and their heirs respectively, the aforesaid shares & portions of land aforesaid with the appurtenances unto the sd Rawlings his heirs & assigns shall & well warrant & by these presents defend from & against the claim or claims of all persons whatsoever forever: In Testimony whereof the said Begain & wife, Boydon & wife, John A. Selden & wife, Miles C. Selden & wife, Ann A. Selden & wife, Miller & wife & C. H. Edsel have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the aforesaid above written (to wit January 5th 1837.)
