S. Williams before this writing and delivery of these presents (the receipt of which I hereby acknowledge) hath bargained and sold and by these presents with bargain and sell unto the said B. S. Williams a certain tract of land or tract of land lying in the County and State aforesaid bounded on the east by the Blackwater River on the south by J. S. Williams' line on the west by a line of Harry's line to the line of Harry (Whitfield) a spine & making a corner tree between Dennis Robertson, Mary Whitfield & Elizabeth Johnson thence with Robertson's line to the line of Uriah G. Gardner's heirs and North by the land of George Hemp & Blackwater River containing One hundred & Thirteen acres, more or less, to the said B. S. Williams his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Elizabeth Johnson for herself her heirs & assigns forever and defend the said tract or parcel of land to have and to hold to him the said B. S. Williams his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or claims of her, her heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever by these presents. Witnesseth That the said Rinchon Williams and Rebeccah his wife in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Matthew R. Pope at the writing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said Matthew R. Pope his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing one hundred and forty three acres more or less and bounded as follows on the south by Dennis Road on the West by Mills & Gray on the North by John A. Turner and on the east by the lands of Nathan Pope, it being the tract formerly belonging to Elisha Williams then to Mon Williams and lastly to Rinchon Williams together with all and singular of the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining with every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular thereto appurtenant hereinafter mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Matthew R. Pope his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Rinchon Williams and Rebeccah his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Matthew R. Pope his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Rinchon Williams and Rebeccah his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall, will, and do warrant and forever defend by the presents.
