Burgess doth stand justly indebted to the said William Barden in the just sum of one hundred and twenty four dollars, seventy one cents, bearing even date with these presents, due by note, now the said Hanna M. Burgess being willing and desirous to extinguish and secure the said William Barden the above amount doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Jonathan T. Griffin the following property (to wit) one bay Mare & Cart, three feather beds & furniture, one spinning Wheel & cards, two sitting chairs, one sofa, two tables, two pots, one spider, two axes, five fowls, one fowls lighter head of dogs, say short size, four sows and their pigs, five head of sheep, one cow, all my part of my (present growing) crop of corn fodder peas and bottom two fine chest nine gas. To him the said Jonathan T. Griffin to have and to hold to him and his heirs forever on special Trust and confidence, and the said Burgess doth by these presents warrant and will forever defend all Rights title in trust and claims in and to the same unto him the said J. T. Griffin and his heirs & his assigns forever nevertheless it is hereby agreed and understood that at the request of either of the parties that the said J. T. Griffin shall proceed to advertise the said before mentioned property and make sale thereof on ten day after for lease and after (paying) off the said debt and interest unto him the said Hanna M. Burgess or his representative or order all the surplus money arising from the said sale of any to which we her unto set lower hand and affix our seals this day and date above written.
