 and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid  
 tract let or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging, unto him the  
 said John Barrett his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John  
 Barrett his heirs and assigns forever) and the said Allen Hill and Martha his Wife, Benjamin Beal & Elizabeth  
 his Wife for themselves their heirs executors and assigns, do, and each of them with, hereby covenant and agree  
 to and with the said John Barrett his heirs executors and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and for-  
 ever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract let or parcel of land and premises and every part or parcel  
 thereof, against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof

This Indenture made and entered into this the 11. day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and thirty seven between Charles Hunt of the first part and William M. Butler the trustee part and John Hargrave of the third  
 part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Charles Hunt stands justly indebted to the said John  
 Hargrave by bond bearing even date with these presents in the sum of thirty two dollars and — cents, which debt with the legal  
 interest thereon the said Charles Hunt is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of  
 the sum of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said Charles Hunt in hand paid by the said William M. Butler the  
 trustee at and before sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Charles  
 Hunt both giving, granting, bargain, sell, alien, infess, release and confirm and by these presents with giving, grant, bar-  
 gain, sell, alien, infess, release and confirm to the said William M. Butler his heirs and assigns forever the following personal pro-  
 perty, to wit, two filled beds and furniture, one green safe, 30 (Thirty) shaws of L. & heads of Hops and their increase all one hoop  
 of wood and (Sassafras) now growing, two iron pots — one oven, 1 frying pan, one set of Shoemakers tools (scabbles) axes, two  
 wess hoes, 1 bottom hoe, 2 water pails, 1 wainscot, one pair of flat irons, 1 sheet, 1 blanket, 1 shawl with all the right title &  
 interest of the said Charles Hunt in and to the above mentioned property hereby granted. To have and to hold the said  
 hereby granted premises together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto in anywise appertaining unto the said  
 William M. Butler the trustee his heirs executors administrators
