Up to with all right, title interest claim or demands of, in and to the above described tract let of parcels of lands and premises both its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract let of parcels of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said John Barrett his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Barrett his heirs and assigns forever) and the said Allen Hill and Martha his wife, Benjamin Beal & Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs executors and assigns do, and each of them with hereby covenant and agree and with the said John Barrett his heirs executors and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract let of parcels of land and premises and every part or parcel thereof, against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. We Alexander Myrick & James Maget Justices of the peace in the County aforesaid, in the State of Virginia, do hereby certify that Martha Hill, the wife of Allen Hill and Elizabeth Beal the wife of Benjamin Beal parties to a certain deed bearing date on the 30th day of July 1836 and hereto annexed personally appeared before us, in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from their husbands and having the said instruments fully explained to them, they the said Martha Hill and Elizabeth Beal acknowledged the same to be their act and deed and declared that they had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that they wished not to retract it. This Indenture made and entered into this the 11th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Charles Hunt of the first part and William M. Butler the trustee part and John Hargrave of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Charles Hunt stands justly indebted to the said John Hargrave by bond bearing even date with these presents in the sum of thirty two dollars and — cents, which debt with the legal interest thereon, the said Charles Hunt is willing and desirous to secure. Now this indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said Charles Hunt in hand paid by the said William M. Butler the trustee at and before sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Charles Hunt he hath given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, infesseth release and confirmed and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, infesseth release and confirm to the said William M. Butler his heirs and assigns forever the following personal property to wit, two silver plated bras and furniture, one silver safe, 30 dollar chair & 2 heads of sheep and their increase all my crop of corn and cotton now growing two iron pots — one oven, 1 frying pan, one set of shoemakers tools scissoring, awes, two wools hoes, 1 bottom hoe, 2 water spades, 1 woad tub, one pair of flat irons, 1 chest, 1 blanket, 1 shawl with all the right title & interest of the said Charles Hunt in and to the above mentioned property hereby granted. I shew and withhold the said hereby granted (personal) property as above mentioned unto the said William M. Butler the trustee the heirs executors administrators
