Witness that the said John Davis, Robert Rich & John Rich for the consideration of the sum of Nine hundred dollars to them paid or to be paid except the expenses for the benefit of the heirs of sd Henry Joyner at or before the ensuing and delivery of these presents — have sold at public auction to James Rich his heirs executors or assigns one certain tract of Land and premises containing by a late survey three hundred and twenty seven Acres and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at a black gum tree in the Swamp between William and sd tract to the corner there at line of marked trees between the heirs of Owen Rich and said land to a corner in the Swamp between Capt John Davis land and sd tract at a line of marked trees the various courses of said Swamp between the said tract and Davis to the corner in the widows lower as find thence a line of marked trees between said tract and said Davis to the first station.
