This Indenture made this 18th day of Sept. In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven
 between Ryed Sunday & Rebecca Sunday his wife of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and
 Sterling Sledge of the said County & State aforesaid of the other (part) witnesseth that the said Ryed & Rebecca his
 wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & nine dollars & twenty cents to them in hand paid by the said
 Sterling Sledge hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Sterling
 Sledge a certain tract or parcel of Land which the said Sunday purchased at the sale of John Shepherd deceased lying
 and being in the County and State aforesaid and containing by a late survey twenty three acres to the same more or less
 and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a red oak bush on the road a corner to Job Harris then along said road
 as it meanders to the said Sledge's line along his line N 32° E 96 poles N 61° W 37 1/2 poles N 11° W 38 1/2 poles
 to the said Job Harris's line along his line N 75° E 27 poles to a stake a new corner to the said Job Harris thence
 his line S 19° E 68 poles to an opposite S 4° E 30 poles and S 18° W 78 poles to the beginning. To have and to hold
 the same bargained and sold premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
 unto the said Sterling Sledge his heirs executors, administrators and assigns. The right title claim or interest of the said

This Indenture made and entered into this 11th day of September 1837 between Williams Nick of first part, Henry
 Blew of the second part and Joe McMurtry of the third part. Whereas Williams Nick stands justly indebted to the said first part
 by bond bearing equal date with these presents for the sum of Three Hundred and Thirty eight dollars and 88 cents, also
 one other bond bearing equal date payable on the 1st day of October next for the sum of forty two dollars & 88 cents, also
 unto which adds together the interest accruing thereon and the cost attending these presents, the said Williams Nick is ready
 and agrees to pay: From this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further sum in
 addition of the sum of one dollar of lawful money to the said Williams Nick in hand paid by the said Henry Blew, at and to
 for the canceling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said Williams Nick both for
 now, granted, bargained and sold, alien, enfeoffed, released and confirmed by these presents with full, present, bargain, and
 sell, also covenants release and confirm to the said Henry Blew his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the County of Southampton, on the south side of Notterway River containing three hundred acres of land to
 the same more or less, bounded by the lands of Joshua Nicks & others and lying immediately on Notterway River blew his former
 slaves, to wit, with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging to my
